

1 VENTURA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 401

2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA,
3 ACCEPTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE COUNTY
4 EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT ACT OF 1937 (CHAPTER
5 677, STATUTES OF 1937), AND ESTABLISHING
6 A RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR THE OFFICERS AND
7 EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA AND
8 DISTRICTS THEREIN.

9 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura do
10 ordain as follows, to-wit:

11 SECTION 1:

12 Pursuant to the authority granted to it under the pro-
13 visions of the County Employees Retirement Act of 1937 (Chapter
14 677, Statutes of 1937), and in order to recognize a public obliga-
15 tion to such of its employees as may be incapacitated by age or
16 long service in public employment and its accompanying physical
17 disabilities by making provisions for retirement compensation
18 and death benefit as additional elements of compensation for
19 future service, and at the same time to provide a means whereby
20 public employees who may become incapacitated may be replaced by
21 more capable employees to the betterment of the public service
22 without prejudice and without inflicting a hardship upon the
23 employees removed, the Board of Supervisors of the County of
24 Ventura does hereby accept the provisions of said County Employees
25 Retirement Act of 1937, and in compliance therewith and in pursuance
26 thereof does hereby establish within the County of Ventura a
27 retirement system of and for the employees of the County of Ventura
28 and of the districts therein permitted, or entitled to, membership
29 in such system.

30 SECTION 2:

31 Said employees retirement system within the County of
32 Ventura shall be known as and called the Ventura County Employees
Retirement Association.

1 SECTION 3:

2 This ordinance shall be submitted to the vote of the
3 qualified electors of Ventura County at a special election to be
4 held on the 4th day of June, 1946, and shall go into effect upon
5 its receiving the affirmative vote of the majority of the electors
6 voting on the proposition. This ordinance shall be published prior
7 to the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the date hereof for
8 at least one (1) week in the The Ventura County Star-Free Press,
9 a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of
10 Ventura, State of California, together with the names of the
11 members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the
12 same.
